Talking about scary, Harry's been playing with the Google 3D tool after watching Chester Zoo live... terrifying!



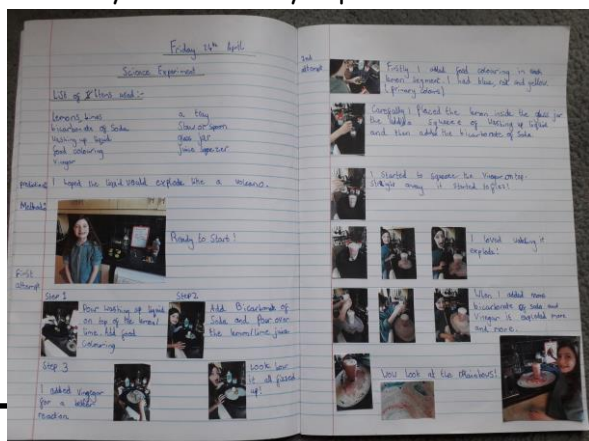
Near(ish) Asteroid!
