Maths

This term, we focus on our number skills using fluency, problem solving and reasoning. The topics we cover are:

- Place value.
- Addition & subtraction

Science

Rocks

Discover different types of rocks, how they are formed and investigate the permeability of different types of soil.

Learn different types of plants and what they need to grow. Investigate the transportation of water within plants.

Geography

The Street Beneath My Feet

We learn about the destructive powers of nature, from volcanoes and earthquakes to tsunamis and tornadoes. Through discussion and practical tasks, we will learn about how and why these natural phenomena occur, and the ways in which they affect people.

History

We learn how the period impacted on life in Britain. How early man survived in a harsh environment and about homes, food, tools and defence, Investigate Skara Brae & how archaeological evidence is important. Learn different theories about Stonehenge.

RE and PSHE
