## NATURE NINJA POND PROJECT

Our Nature Ninjas met with Mike from Collins Landscapes last week to discuss the installation of our new pond. We are all very excited to have a pond in school; the new pond will be dug out and situated in our quad area during the February half term.

Mike spoke with the Nature Ninjas about biodiversity and different forms of life we might expect to see in the newly established pond. Biodiversity means creating an environment that supports a range of different forms of life. We are building a pond to support life to survive in our school and to encourage new life to settle.

We also discussed the dangers of having a pond in the school grounds. The pond will be shallow and will have a fence around it to keep everyone safe. The Nature Ninjas will be creating posters to ensure everyone keeps out of the pond area.

When we were outside deciding where the pond will go, we were so excited to notice lots of shoots coming through from the bulbs we planted in the Autumn. We also learnt some new words...


