I hope you managed to have some kind of break over the summer.

We are really looking forward to welcoming all children back this week: Year 3 tomorrow and the rest of the school the following day on Friday.

We've had to make some changes to the school to make it as safe as possible. We've put together a short video which shows your child what to expect on their first day back. Please click the link below: School Tour

Before we start, there are some really important reminders I would like to draw your attention to:

- Please be on time. We are unable to accommodate lateness. If your child misses their start time, you
 will be expected to wait with them until they can be safely escorted to their class. This will mean
 crossing bubbles unnecessarily and putting others at risk.
- 2. Please observe our one way system on site. The entrance at the front of school is on Hulme Street and the exit is on to Hempshaw Lane. You can also enter at the back through the single gate on the field with the exit through the double gates.
- 3. You can wait for your child at the end of the day in our designated waiting areas. If you are picking up siblings, please collect them at the later siblings finish time in their bubble waiting area.
- 4. Please remember to observe a 2m social distance with members of staff and other families on the playground and field.
- 5. Please remember to send your child in with a jumper: all windows in school will be open so it could get

Face Masks

Quarantine

If you have recently returned from a country that is on the government's quarantine list, please ensure your child does not come in to school until the 14 day quarantine period is over. Please call the school office if this is the case.
