ARRANGEMENTS FOR AUTUMN CEILIDH

OUR AUTUMN EVENT. It is our Autumn Ceilidh on Friday 20th November which is next Friday. Because it is a special party* I will need time to prepare for the event after school. Therefore, I will not be running MY SESSIONS after school. *HOWEVER MUSIC LESSONS ARE STILL HAPPENING AS THE STAFF ARE IN.*

HELP SETTING UP. I would be grateful for any help setting up from any children who are waiting behind for lessons. I would like the trainees to arrive as early as possible to help too. If anyone has a problem over child minding on Friday I am happy for their children to stay and help me too.

THE PROCEEDINGS. The running order for the evening will be as follows :

• The doors will open at 6.30pm. There will be chairs and benches out for the Fosbrook children and tables and chairs out for the families. 'Starter snacks' and drinks would be a good idea before supper.

• The Fosbrooks will play and there will be tunes and songs from the junior, intermediate and senior ensembles. There will be presentations of certificates and trophies too.

SUPPER. We will be having supper after the Fosbrook performance. Please bring a basket of supper as the tables will be out. You will also need any plates, cutlery and glasses and something to drink. THE CEILIDH. The ceilidh band are **'Banter'**. This band used to be the Liam Robinson Dance Band, but sadly Liam is ill and can't perform at the moment. We wish him a speedy recovery.
