LATENESS

We are writing to all families about the vital importance of ensuring your child arrives at school on time every morning.

We understand that mornings can be hectic, we have recently reviewed the time lost due to late arrivals and the results are significant:

Total Minutes of School Time Lost
628 minutes (over 10 hours)
548 minutes (over 9 hours)

Why Every Minute Counts

Less structured social time: Children who arrive late miss the opportunity to spend less structured social time with their friends, and the opportunity to build relationships with their peers.

Pupil Wellbeing: Rushing to school and entering a busy classroom late can be a stressful, unsettling experience. This can contribute to increased anxiety or a negative attitude toward school for the late pupil.

Missed Information: Pupils often miss important morning announcements, instructions, and the crucial 'settling' period that prepares them for the day's learning.

Lost Learning: Every minute lost is a minute of learning and engagement that may not be recovered.
