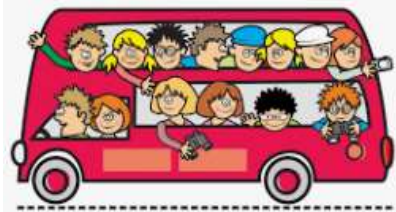

PUPIL PREMIUM PLUS

If your child was previously looked after by a Local Authority in England or Wales immediately before being adopted, subject to a special guardianship order, a child arrangement order or a residence order, the school can claim additional monies (£2345) each year via Pupil Premium Plus funding to support the educational needs of your child.

Declaration is on a voluntary basis. If you would like us to claim for your child, you must inform us before Thursday, 20th January 2022. We will need to see a copy of the court order or a letter from the Local Authority that placed the child with you. We will then update our annual census.

Please be aware that this information must be declared each time your child starts a new school. Therefore, if this applies to your child, and it is your child's first year with us, we would appreciate it if you could make contact with us. We are happy to discuss the use of Pupil Premium with you. You can also view our Pupil Premium Strategy and Action Plan on our school website:

INDIVIDUAL DRESS YOUR BIKE COMPETITION

If you have your own bike – we would like you to dress it up using whatever materials you like to represent a 'HERO OF THE PANDEMIC'. This could be a nurse, doctor, bin man, teacher, a particular person or whoever or whatever you think has been a hero over the last year.

If we would like you to bring your dressed up bike to St Peter's Square in Stockport at any time between 10am and 3pm during Saturday 18th September to enter it into the competition or just bring your bike and dress it up at the schools' stand, we'll have materials for you to use.

If we will take a photo and display this on our display board for everyone to see. Your bike will then be judged with all the others brought in from your category (KS1, KS2, KS3) the following day by Stockport's Paralympic Cyclist, Megan Giglia.

If Every participant will receive a prize and winners will be announced and awarded at 1pm on the Sunday with a certificate and a voucher for Manchester's BMX centre.

If You will have the opportunity to lock your bike up along the barriers while you and your family enjoy the festivities. (We will provide a lock for anyone who needs one).
