ABSENCE

We understand that in certain circumstances absence from school is unavoidable, these include illness, medical appointments, and religious celebrations. In order for these absences to be authorised school must be informed of the reason either by phone, in person or in writing for each date of absence. We ask that in the case of a medical appointment, an appointment card/letter must be seen by a member of staff in the school office. We also ask that wherever possible medical appointments are made outside of school hours.

Please find attached our new attendance policy. This has been implemented, as directed by the Local Authority who are working remotely to ensure continiuty across all schools in Stockport.

PUPIL PREMIUM

Previously Looked After Children

Pupil Premium Plus

If your child was previously looked after by a local authority in England or Wales immediately before being adopted, subject to a special guardianship order, a child arrangement order or residence order, the school can claim additional monies (£2300) each year via Pupil Premium Plus funding to support the educational needs of your child.

Declaration is on a voluntary basis. If you would like us to claim for your child, you must inform us before **Thursday 17th January 2019**. We will need to see a copy of the court order or a letter from the local authority that placed the child with you. We will then update our annual census.

Please be aware that this information must be declared each time your child starts a new school. Therefore, if this applies to your child, and it is your child's first year with us, we would appreciate it if you could make contact with us.
