COVID REPORTING

You may be aware, Public Health England have asked schools to be contactable for the first 6 days of the Christmas break to ensure track and trace is covered in full over the holidays.

Please read the guidance below so you are aware of the arrangements we have put in place for the reporting of positive Covid-19 tests over the Christmas period.

On the 19th, 20th, 21st, 22nd, 23rd and 24th December our school admin email address will be active and checked at 9am every day.

If your child shows Covid symptoms before Monday 21st and then goes on to test positive, please email <u>admin@bankslane-</u> jun.stockport.sch.uk and include:


- 1. Child's name and class
- 2. Symptoms start date
- 3. Test date
- 4. Result date

If your child starts to show symptoms for Covid-19 from Monday 21st December, please follow the Government track and trace system directly.

Please note - only emails regarding Covid-19 positive cases will be actioned over the holidays, all other emails will be replied to upon our return on Thursday 7th January.

We are all hoping we do not have to contact any families to ask your child to isolate over the holidays and will only do so if absolutely necessary. Please be assured we will follow Local Authority and Public Health England guidance on isolation in the same way we would throughout term time.
