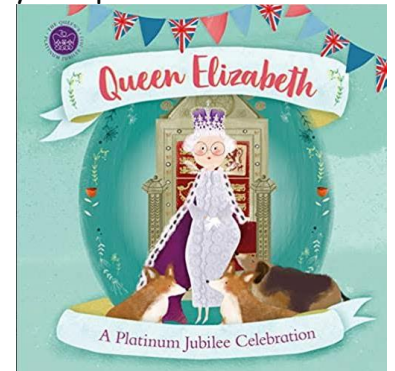

Year 3 - Jacob, 3S for showing amazing positivity and enthusiasm.

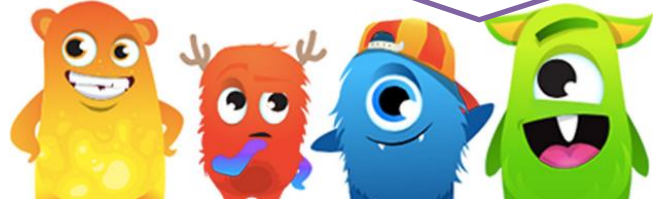
Year 4 - Alex, 4L for his perseverance and resilience in swimming.

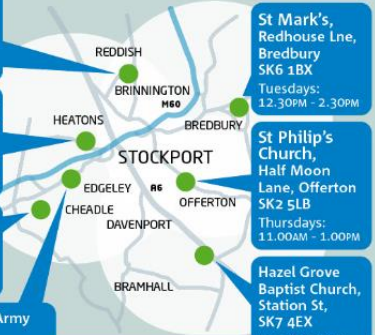
