A further request from parents was to give some guidance on putting parental controls on different devices. To do this on a PS4 it is:

How to restrict access to Network Features

Go to [Settings] > [Parental Controls/Family Management] > [Family Management]. You may need to enter your account password.

Select the user you want to set restrictions for, then select [Applications/Devices/Network Features] under the Parental Controls section.

Under 'Network Features' you can choose whether to allow a child family member to communicate with other players on PSN or view content created by other players.
