Amber Home Challenge

There is only one solution to this challenge

Use the clues below to work out which number is a multiple of 6 between 0 and 60.

- Mrs Harvey + Miss Bastin = 40
- Miss Bastin + Miss Russell = Mrs Harvey
- Miss Russell + Miss Selby = 25
- Mr Threader + Miss Bastin = Mrs Constant
- Mr Threader - Miss Russell = 15
- Mrs Constant + Miss Selby = Mrs Whitaker

Clues:

- Mrs Constant and Mr Threader have a 5 in the ones column.
- Miss Bastin is half of Miss Russell.

Use the clues below to work out each teacher's number. Each number has up to 2 decimal places and is between 0 and 6.

- Mrs Windas + Miss Rock = 4.5
- Mrs Howarth + Mr Bassett = Mrs Windas
- Mr Bassett + Mrs Daniels = 3.75
- Mrs Daniels + Miss Thorley = 1.25
- Mr Bassett - Miss Rock = Mr Walker
- . 6 - Miss Rock = Mrs Scott

Clues:

- Mrs Howarth and Mrs Frost are both numbers less than one. (0.5 and anything you like! Mrs Frost's number didn't matter)
- 3 teachers are whole numbers. (Mr W, Mrs W, Miss T)
- Mrs Scott is a number with two decimal places between 2 and 3. The sum of her digits is 9. (2.16 as 2+1+6=9)
