DROP AND GO PICK UP AND LEAVE

Unfortunately, there are some parents who are coming onto the playground much too early and neither they, nor their children, are staying 2 metres apart. Some are even standing close and talking to parents from other bubbles. We are also aware of other schools in the area either asking for children to be dropped off at the gates or requiring all adults to wear face masks. We feel we have a big enough site to avoid this but would please ask you not to become complacent.

Please follow our risk assessment:

- bring your child to school at their allotted time
- if possible, drop them and leave there are several members of staff on the playground
- if you stay; please remain 2 metres apart from anyone else
- please do not come too close to our staff maintain social distance at all times
- please adhere to all one way systems

When COVID comes into our school, we will have to shut a class at the very least, possibly a bubble. We are trying really hard not only to protect our community but also to prevent disruption to our families' lives. With half term coming up, we are getting increasingly concerned we may have to ask families to isolate over the holidays Everyone has worked so hard since returning and we would love for everyone to have an enjoyable break.

NASAL FLU VACCINATIONS

Our school is booked in for nasal flu vaccinations on Tuesday 3rd November. We believe some parents have been sent a barcode to be brought in by children on the day of vaccinations.

Intrahealth (who administer the vaccinations at school) have assured us children do not need to bring the barcodes into school. All children who have been given permission online will receive the vaccination in school.
