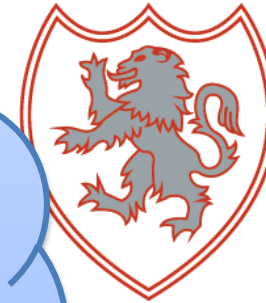


Mrs Stoddart - Spanish Teacher

What I do at school

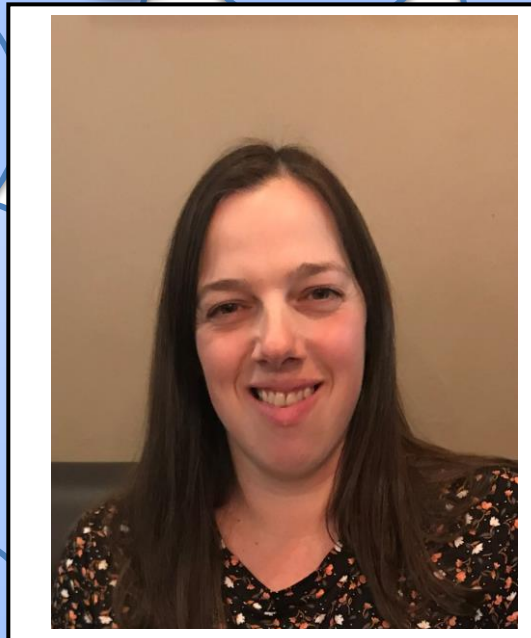
