How I can help you

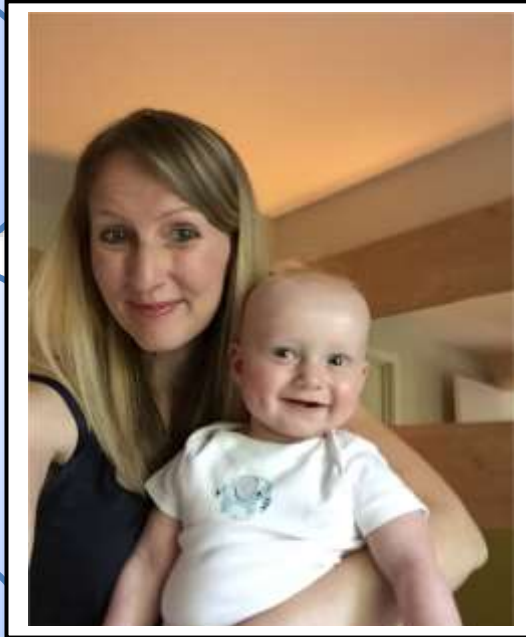
